Addiction Studies prepares you to work as an in-demand CDP (chemical dependency provider) where the need for qualified providers is exploding, and federal laws have fueled this demand.

- There are less than 50 CDPs per 1,000 “non-elderly adults with a drug or alcohol addiction” in Washington State.¹
- 21.7% of the population in Medicaid expansion has a substance abuse disorder in Washington State.²
- The 2008 Mental Health Parity and Addiction Equity Act requires all insurers provide the same level of care for substance abuse as medical and surgical care.³
